HOPE RISES FOR BIRLAND RECOGNITION BY TWO COUNTRIES

The coast is getting clear for the State of Birland, Africa's newest and 55th country in the continent, to consolidate its diplomatic status and relations as opening communication has been initiated by the Hon. Minister of Foreign Affairs, **Professor Barika Dominic Saro-Laka, JP**.

Addressing journalists in Pretoria, the minister, explained that the move promises better deal for all supporters of the new country.

According to him, the move will offer great opportunities for supporters of Birland to obtain visas to travel, do business or study with ease in those two countries (names withheld) and widen the horizon of growth and development for those wishing to tap from such opportunities.

Professor Saro-Laka hinted that the two country leaders were excited to hear about Birland's existence and its philosophy of promoting diversity, friendship and bilateral ties with other countries of the world discrimination and segregation.

Speaking further, the Hon. Minister explained that the uniqueness and survival strategies of Birland are tied to the passion, visionary prowess and exemplary leadership styles of its Head of State, **His Majesty, King Dr. Emir Haiyaw** and the Prime Minister, **Queen Prof. Eden Soriano Trinidad**.

The minister expressed strong optimism about Birland being favoured to obtain diplomatic recognition from these two countries before the end of May, 2025.

Responding to further questions, the professor added that areas of bilateral ties would include trade, tourism, cultural exchange, academic exchange, technological transfer, agriculture, skills acquisition development, sports, energy and the development of the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprise Sector, among others.

Continuing, Saro-Laka disclosed that Birland has the largest pool of experts covering different sectors of the economy while countries that engage in bilateral relations with Birland stand to benefit a lot in terms of human capacity-building.

He assured that the new country is destined for speedy growth given the vast diversity of professionals and technocrats that have shown interest in jump-starting the progress of the virgin country with many green opportunities.

The Hon. Minister disclosed that Birland has received hundreds of recognitions, endorsements and partnerships from various organizations, establishments and institutions. "This development shows widespread global acceptance for our new country", he added.

Saro-Laka, a philanthropist and also the president of the Association of Patriotic African Professors (APAP) hinted of plans to assign a Birland Desk at the Technical Training Workshop for International Peace Advocates and Development Catalysts holding in Abuja, Nigeria, at Labour House, on 9th January, 2025, so as to spread the good news about the new country.
