BIRLAND DIGITAL BREAKTHROUGH: BGP EXPANDS TO THE GLOBAL NETWORK



The Prime Minister of the State of Birland, Her Excellency Queen Eden Soriano Trinidad, has announced a remarkable milestone in the nation's digital advancement. Following an official update from His Excellency Prof. Dr. Jamil Izzatov, Minister of Digital Technologies, Communications, and Mass Media, the Birland Global Payment (BGP) system has successfully transitioned from a domestic platform to a fully operational global digital network.

According to Prof. Dr. Izzatov, when the BGP was first launched over a month ago, its functions were primarily limited to internal operations within Birland's digital ecosystem. However, with this latest breakthrough, the BGP is now capable of operating freely across the international digital finance landscape, signaling Birland's growing presence and influence in global innovation and fintech development.

Her Excellency Queen Eden Soriano Trinidad expressed her deep appreciation for the progress led by the Ministry of Digital Technologies and commended the technical team for their commitment to excellence and vision. She described the global activation of the BGP as "a bold step toward Birland's financial independence and digital sovereignty."

This achievement builds upon the Prime Minister's official visit to St. Petersburg, Russian Federation, on September 24, 2025, where she engaged in high-level meetings with Birland's Digital Development team under the leadership of Prof. Dr. Jamil Izzatov. During the visit, discussions centered on advancing the Birland Digital Currency (BGP) and strengthening the Birland Digital Bank, which is now fully operational.

Prof. Dr. Izzatov and his team—comprising experts in digital finance, blockchain technology, law, and cybersecurity—continue to develop innovative systems designed to enhance the stability, transparency, and global integration of Birland's digital economy. These developments mark a major step forward in Birland's digital transformation agenda, underscoring the government's commitment to building a sustainable, inclusive, and globally connected economy for all citizens. 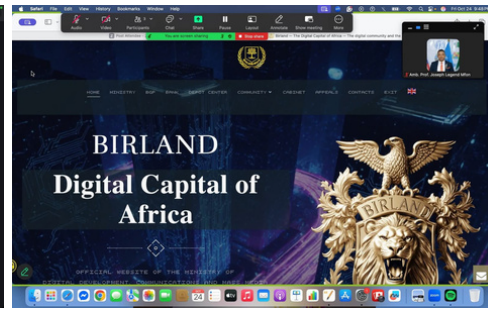

Address to the Esteemed Ministers of Birland

Virtual Meeting, October 24, 2025

Good evening, Your Excellencies, the Honorable Ministers of the State of Birland.

As the Prime Minister of our cherished digital state, it is with great pride—and a touch of solemnity—that I address you today. Over the past decade, Birland has grown as a digital nation, and I am heartened to see many of you still standing with us. However, I must express that while I am glad, I am not entirely satisfied, as our journey demands more from all of us.

The creation of the Birland Digital Currency, the BGP, marks a monumental milestone for our nation. To have our own currency is no small feat—it is, without question, the most significant achievement in Birland's history thus far. While a currency, whether fiat or digital, does not solely define a nation—consider countries like Timor-Leste, the British Virgin Islands, El Salvador, Turks and Caicos, and Zimbabwe, which use the US dollar as their official currency—it is a powerful symbol of sovereignty and progress. For Birland, the BGP is a testament to our vision and resilience.

It has been some time since our last virtual meeting. I have had the privilege of meeting a few of you in person, including our esteemed Minister in Nepal H.E. Mingma Dorjee Sherpa, the Minister of Tourism and Representative in Nepal, H.E. Debendra KC the Minister of Aviation, during our activities there. We met our new Minister, His Excellency King Spumendo Mberudo Mokgabuti from South Africa, and, most recently, the Minister of Digital Development, Professor Jamil Izzatov, in Russia. These encounters have been inspiring, but they also remind me of the work that lies ahead.

As you know, I am highly active on our group platform on WhatsApp and across social media, where I share updates on my efforts for Birland. Our unique situation as a digital state requires constant visibility to remain relevant in a world of physical nations. Unlike traditional countries, we are not bound by land but by our shared vision and actions. This demands that I—and all of you—remain vocal, visible, and engaged every single day.

Today, I speak to you heart-to-heart, my fellow Birland Ministers. Some of you are absent from this meeting without explanation, and while I respect your commitments, let me be clear: action speaks louder than words.

At this moment, I want to set the tone for our collective responsibility.

Every Birland Minister must take ownership of their ministry. You are tasked with developing your respective industries, raising funds, and promoting your work both within your country and globally. Many of you have connections and networks beyond your borders—use them. Make this a way of life.

You are not young graduates or novices; you are seasoned professionals, capable and experienced.

After years with Birland, you understand that we are building a nation from the ground up. I should not need to micromanage your responsibilities.

If I were to take on your duties, what would be the purpose of your roles?

Take inspiration from our Minister of Digital Development, who has built a team to advance his vision.

Consider Lukman, a university student who joined us as a high schooler. He volunteered as my designer, helping to launch the Birland newsletter without expecting payment. He feels honored to serve Birland, and I have committed to supporting his graduation fees for the six-month international course offered by BIR University. Similarly, Chika Udekwe, who worked with me early on, contributed writings for Birland. When he needed assistance, I helped him secure a job at DHL by providing a recommendation. DHL became curious to see his person—he contacted me.



These examples show that while money is important, resourcefulness and dedication are what drive us forward when resources are scarce. We are not merely maintaining a nation; we are creating one. This requires collective effort, not just my own. Some of you have taken steps forward, and I commend you, but sporadic actions—once-a-year initiatives—are not enough. The world will only notice Birland if we are consistent and relentless. My daily social media presence, reposting and engaging, is not just routine—it's strategic. It keeps Birland relevant, sparks curiosity, and builds momentum. Those who ignored us before are now clicking "like" and following our journey.

Look at the Poets of Birland. I didn't just watch them post greetings or poems in our group chats and FB account. I engaged with them, and after four years of effort, we published a collection of their poems written for Birland since 2021. This was a dream I promised to fulfill, and seeing their pride as published Poets of Birland is a reward in itself.

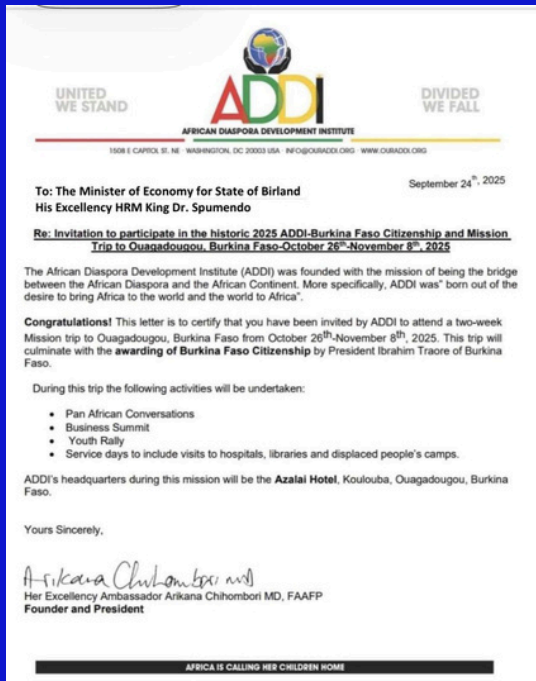
That effort led me to Russia, where I met our Minister of Digital Development and visited our offices—a remarkable milestone that shows what active engagement can achieve.

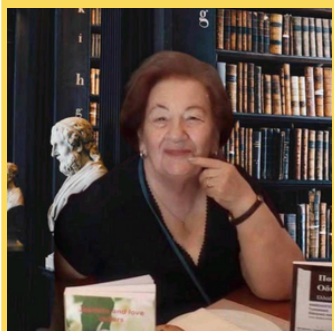
UNDER THE SAME SKY

for Hope, for Peace...

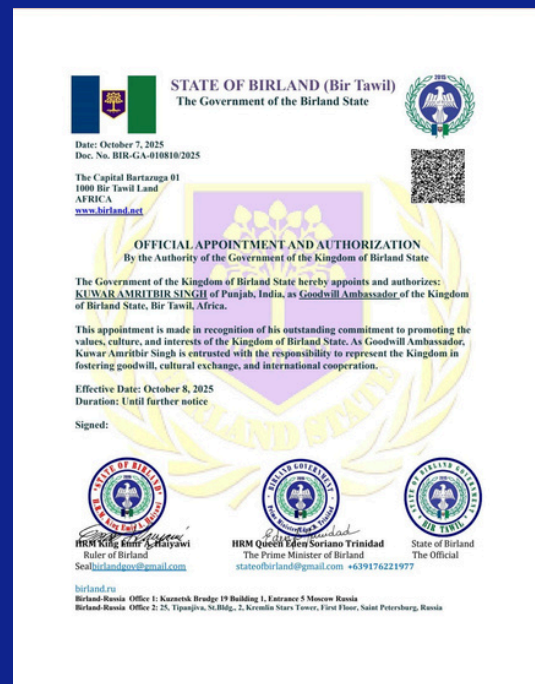
May one day
